Econsultancy had a turnover of approximately EUR 15 million in 2022 and Sweco Netherlands had a turnover of approximately EUR 214 million in 2022. The acquisition closed on January 3 and Econsultancy will be consolidated into Sweco as of January.

The acquisition is in line with Sweco's acquisition strategy to grow the business by adding key competencies that complement Sweco's 21, 000 experts, and it will strengthen the offering to clients as well as expand the Group's market position as Europe's leading architecture and engineering consultancy.
